C.A.R.E. Human Service Model: For years, those of us in human services have learned and applied principles such as positive approaches and person-centered planning. This training offers an overview and introduces a new model based on Community, Autonomy, Relationships, and Ego. *Zoom - \$15/person. Select one of the following:*

The Impact of Trauma: Research shows abuse is more common among people with disabilities, with at least 85% experiencing trauma. Resources to understand their thoughts and feelings are limited, yet it's essential to understand each person's experience to ensure they feel safe and prevent challenging behaviors. This training teaches caregivers about trauma, how it affects people with disabilities, and how to support their safety and trauma management. *Zoom - \$15/person. Select one of the following:*

Neuro & Gender Diversity: Recent research shows overlap between autism spectrum and gender diversity. This session won't explore causes but will focus on supporting autistic individuals expressing gender diversity. *Zoom - \$15/person. Select one of the following:*

Navigating Sexuality: This training helps parents and professionals guide people with disabilities in addressing sexuality healthily and safely, offering basic and advanced strategies for managing sexual feelings, relationships, and dating. *Zoom - \$15/person. Select one of the following:*

Approaching Sexual Behaviors: This training is for professionals and individuals involved with sexual behaviors. It explores factors linked to these behaviors and offers strategies for prevention and intervention to promote safer, healthier sexuality practices. *Zoom - \$15/person. Sexual Risk/Assessment Screenings (Juvenile & Adult): This two-day course with Shawn McGill, MSW, LSW, requires students to submit three Risk Screening Reports and Plans for feedback, complete 10 mentoring sessions, and complete the course within 8-12 months. Students will learn to conduct sexual consent screenings, administer ERASOR, RRASOR/Static-99, and the Armidillo-S, and produce detailed reports. Prerequisites apply; completion depends on progress and client access. *This training is conducted virtually. The fee is \$ 2,500 per person. Select one of the following:*
